Bruce Shackleford of Environmental Consulting Inc. oversaw a prescribed burn today at the Woolsey Wet Prairie near the Westside Wastewater Treatment Plant in Fayetteville. Shackleford conducts species inventories twice a year and has identified 334 species of native plants and animals at the 70-acre natural wetland preserve.
